



Winter Concert - Monday, December 14, 2020
Gulf Breeze High School Stadium - 6:00 pm

6th Period

- Load Truck of all large instruments, percussion, chairs, & stands.
- All wind instruments will be taken over to the stadium with the student. They can be picked up directly after school.
- Students need to have their music prepared with a plan to keep their music in place from the wind (tape, clothes pins, binder clips, etc.)

Monday, December 14

- **4:00 Band Room Closed**
 - All students need to have picked up their instrument and music by the time the band room has closed.
- **4:30 Call Time at Stadium for Dress Rehearsal**
 - Unload Truck
 - Set up instruments, chairs, & stands
 - Warm up & play through concert music
 - Depending on your dress rehearsal time, you will have a break either right after setting up OR after your dress rehearsal.
- **5:30** Gates open for audience members
- **5:55** Set in your chair, ready to warm up
- **6:00** Concert Starts!
 - Jazz Band (approx. 10 Mins)
 - Percussion Ensemble (approx. 15 Mins)
 - Concert Band (approx. 12 Mins)
 - Symphonic Band (approx. 18 Mins)
- **7:30** Projected End Time Concert
 - All Students will need to help load equipment back onto the truck.
 - All instruments will go home with students if they were previously loaded onto the truck.
 - We will unload the truck Monday morning during class.

Weather Information

Currently, there is no chance of rain for the concert! It looks like it will be chilly in the upper 50s, so please be sure that your students and family are dressed warmly.



Dress Code

Students are asked to dress nicely for the concert. “Sunday Best” is the general guideline & students may wear jackets and layer their clothes if they are cold. Students are able to wear festive holiday attire as well (Santa hats, reindeer antlers, holiday sweater, etc.) No jeans, joggers, sweatpants, yoga pants, athletic shorts, etc. Khaki, blue, black, gray, etc. pants are fine. Students should wear closed-toed shoes. Dresses should be long enough that they do not come above the knee when sitting down & should be worn with tights/hose. Students must also be wearing masks and may only take them off when they are playing a wind instrument.

Spectators

Due to Covid-19 and the safety guidelines, we are only allowing 500 people in the stadium. Spectators must also wear a mask and practice social distancing in the stands. Families may sit together, but please avoid close-contact mingling. Safety is our #1 priority. I know how much the students have missed performing and how much the community would enjoy having some holiday cheer. Again, your cooperation, understanding, and flexibility is appreciated during this time.
